WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 22, 1969 —CAPTAIN GAVE THE WORD THAT THE BRISTOL IS TO BE SCRAPPED.

TUESDAY, OCTOBER 28, 1969 --- BRISTOL TOWED FROM NEW YORK TO PHILADELPHIA.

THURSDAY, OCTOBER 30, 1969 --- CLOSE OUT SALE SHIP'S STORE.

SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 1, 1969 --- STARTED STRIPPING ALL ITEMS FROM SHIP.

MONDAY, TUESDAY AND WEDNESDAY, --- NOVEMBER 3 - 5, 1969 PUMPED OFF FUEL.

THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 6, 1969 --- REMOVED ALL NON-SECURED ITEMS OFF SHIP.

TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 11, 1969 --- SHIP'S PARTY.

THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 13, 1969 --- FIRE ROOMS AND ENGINE ROOMS EMPTIED AND CLEANED --- LAST SHIP'S PARTY.

THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 20, 1969 --- FINISHED DECOMMISSIONING. CHINA BOUGHT BRISTOL FOR \$20,000.

FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 21, 1969 --- REMAINING CREW LEFT BRISTOL. FLAG LOWERED.
